PRE-HARVEST SAMPLING PROCEDURE

- The fruit must be representative to the crop in question. Please follow the guidelines given.
- Avoid sampling from trees adjacent to shelter belts, end rows, replacement trees, pollinators or abnormal areas.
 - 6-9 Apples per sample is recommended. The Apples should be taken one per tree (6-9 Apples from 6-9 trees)
 - Each variety matures at different rates and sizes, therefore fruitlets should be submitted two weeks before harvest
 - Sample from N,S, E,W sides of the trees to ensure sample is representative
 - Collect approximately shoulder or eye height
 - Avoid Apples showing any physical damage, disorders or abnormalities unless these characteristics are throughout the crop.
 - Avoid unusually large or small Apples. The sample should comprise Apples that would develop into average size graded fruit.
 - Identify and or mark the trees that have been sampled for future reference.
