**FRUITLET SAMPLING PROCEDURE**

- The fruit must be representative to the crop in question. Please follow the guidelines given.
- Avoid sampling from trees adjacent to shelter belts, end rows, replacement trees, pollinators or abnormal areas.
  - 30 Fruitlets per sample is recommended. The Fruitlets should be taken one per tree (30 fruitlets from 30 trees)
  - Fruitlets should be between 30-40 mm diameter; or 20-40 grams; or 100mm circumference minimum
  - Sample from N,S, E,W sides of the trees to ensure sample is representative
  - Collect approximately shoulder or eye height
  - Avoid Fruitlets showing any physical damage, disorders or abnormalities unless these characteristics are throughout the crop.
  - Avoid unusually large or small fruitlets. The sample should comprise Fruitlets that would develop into average size graded fruit.
  - Identify and or mark the trees that have been sampled for future reference.
